


Our planet has some puzzles and STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Math) is our superpower to solve them. Ready, set, STEAM ahead!






What are the SDGs ?

SDG 1: No Poverty


DEFINITION SDG 1 - No Poverty

SDG 2 : Zero Hunger


DEFINITION SDG 2 - Zero Hunger

SDG 3 :Good Health and Well Being


DEFINITION SDG 3 - Good Health and Well Being

SDG 4 : Quality Education


DEFINITION SDG 4 - Quality Education

SDG 5: Gender Equality


DEFINITION SDG 5 - Gender Equality

SDG 6: Clean Water and Sanitation


DEFINITION SDG 6 - Clean Water and Sanitation

SDG 7: Affordable and Clean Energy


DEFINITION SDG 7 - Affordable and Clean Energy


SDG 9: Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure

SDG 10: Reduce Inequalities


DEFINITION SDG 10 - Reduced Inequalities.


SDG 11: Sustainable Cities and Communities


SDG 12: Responsible Consumption and Production

SDG 13: Climate Action


DEFINITION SDG 13 - Climate Action

SDG 14: Life Below Water


DEFINITION SDG 14 - Life Below Water

SDG 15: Life On Land


DEFINITION SDG 15 - Life On Land


SDG 16: Peace, Justice and Strong Institution

SDG 17: Partnerships for the Goals


DEFINITION SDG 17 - Partnership for the Goals.
